WHO WE ARE

IN 2006, BEST OF THE WEST STARTED AS AN ANNUAL SERIES OF COMPETITIONS IN THE WESTERN PART OF BELGIUM. IT WAS A COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF WEST-VLAANDEREN, THE 5 CITY COUNCILS OF OOSTENDE, BRUGGE, KORTRIJK, ROESELARE AND THE WELL RESPECTED SKATEPARK ZUMIEZ.

IN 2012, BEST OF THE WEST BECAME AN INTERNATIONAL EVENT WITH A STOP IN AMSTERDAM. THIS CHALLENGE WAS MET WITH SUCCES AND IN 2013 THE EVENT HAD A STOP IN EINHOVEN (AREA 51) AND PARIS (FAR'N'HIGH)

SINCE 2014, BOTW HAS GROWN TO BE EVEN MORE THAN A SKATEBOARD COMPETITION. BOTW IS ALSO A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION. BEING AN NPO WE CAN INVEST MORE TIME IN SKATEBOARDING IN BELGIUM AND FUNCTION AS A NEGOTIATOR BETWEEN THE SKATERS AND THE CITY COUNCILS. A DEDICATED FIVE MAN STRONG GROUP CONSISTING OF LIFELONG SKATERS, SKATECULTURE AND SKATE-INDUSTRY ENTHUSIASTS AND OUT TO PUSH AND HELP SKATEBOARDERS AND SKATEBOARDING IN BELGIUM AND EUROPE.






BOTW15 BRUGGE FEBRUARI 14TH - 15TH 2015



CATEGORIES

BEST OF THE WEST IS OPEN TO ALL SKATEBOARDERS, ALL AGES, ALL LEVELS. WE TRY TO KEEP IT AS FAIR AS POSSIBLE FOR EVERYBODY SO OUR CONTESTS ARE DIVIDED IN 3 CATEGORIES:

- 14 YEARS AND YOUNGER (YOUNG RIPPERS SKATE FOR FAME AND SKATEBOARDSTUFF)
- 15 YEARS AND OLDER (MORE EXPERIENCED GUYS SKATE FOR FAME AND SKATEBOARDSTUFF)
- ALL AGES OPEN (BRANDSPONSORED SKATERS AND ANYONE ELSE WHO WANTS SKATE FOR HARD CASH)

WE ALLOW MAX 40 RIDERS PER CATEGORY

CONTESTFORMAT

THIS YEAR WE SAY GOODBYE TO THE CLASSIC ONE-MINUTE RUN FORMAT. INSTEAD WE HAVE OPTED FOR A TENNISTABLE FORMAT WITH 5 MINUTE JAMS.

PARTICIPANTS WILL FEEL MORE COMFORTABLE AND LESS STRESSED WHEN SKATING IN 5 MINUTE JAMS WITH '5 SKATERS AT THE SAME TIME THAN HAVING TO SKATE ALONE IN A SINGLE MINUTE RUN.

NOW THERE IS MORE MARGIN FOR ERROR SO SKATERS CAN TRY MORE DIFFICULT TRICKS. THE TENNISTABLE MODEL AND THE MIXING OF THE GROUPS AFTER EVERY ROUND ALLOWS US TO GIVE MAXIMUM OF CHANCES FOR PARTICIPANTS TO REACH THE FINALS.


